## MODERN ROOMY RIGID

THE Atlas hardwood floor cabinets provide rigid support for all types of bench machines and have convenient covered compartments for tools and attachments. Three models are available: Nos. W-101 and W-102 (above) for bench lathes, screw machines, etc. and No. M1-750 (over) with 30" x 18" table for such tools as shapers, milling machines, and drill presses.

The Atlas cabinets are patterned after modern heavyduty scientific laboratory furniture. Massive solidhardwood construction of all principal parts furnishes the extra weight and rigidity required for accurate machine work and smooth, quiet operation. All frame joints are glued, screwed and bolt-reinforced. Table board is  $15/_8$ " thick.

There is plenty of covered space for the clean storage of tools and accessories. Nos. W-101 and W-102 have a roomy drawer ( $71/_2$  inches deep) and a cupboard with pull-down door,  $81/_4$  inches high. No. M1-750 (over) has one open cupboard and one doored cupboard. Doors and drawers are flush-front type, and the entire cabinet is round-cornered and naturalfinished for modern attractive appearance. Each corner has a bored hole for bolting cabinet to floor.


## atlas NO. MI-750 FLOOR CABINET

## FOR SHAPERS, MILLING MACHINES, ETC.

The Atlas No. M1-750 hardwood floor cabinet is designed to furnish firm support for shapers, milling machines, drill presses, and other bench-type machines. The top of the M1-750 cabinet measures  $30'' \times 18''$ .

Details of design are the same as the W-101 and W-102 cabinets described on the opposite side of this bulletin —rugged, solid-hardwood construction; bolt-reinforcing;  $1\frac{5}{8}$ "-thick table board; modern round-cornered flush-front styling. Two roomy cupboards, each  $8\frac{1}{4}$  inches high, provide covered space for the storage of accessories and tools—the right-hand cupboard is open-front, and the one on the left is equipped with a pull-down door with a catch at the horizontal position.
